

ART WITH DR. DEBI DREW

Taught by Dr. Debi L. Drew. As an artist and art educator, she knows that the more she learns, the more she can share; and motivating others to create art and learn new things brings her much joy! She has a PhD and MA in Art Education and BAs in Visual Communications and General Psychology.

GUIDED WHEEL THROWING (Ages 16 and up) (Prerequisite: Learning to Wheel class or past experience throwing on the wheel.) This class is perfect for those who wish to continue working on the wheel to further practice and develop confidence in wheel throwing. Guided help will be individualized according to what each one wants to master on the wheel. All vessels will be glaze fired. \$130 25 lbs of clay will be available for registrants to purchase for class at the Kirby Learning Studios on the first day of class(\$35). Class meetings: Thurs. evenings - Aug. 3, 10, 17, 24 from 6 - 8PM.

CLAY LANTERNS (Ages 16 and up) Slab clay structures will be created and completely carved into to provide patterned openings for candlelight to beautifully shine through. The lanterns will be glazed fired. \$100 (materials included). Class meetings: Sat. evenings - Sept. 16, 23 and 30 from 6 - 8PM.

YOUTH STAMPED PINCH POTS (8-15 yrs old) In this class youth will begin with modeling a ball of clay into a small pot and then they will be decorated on the outside with stamping and a few other decorative techniques if desired. The final piece will be glazed. \$80 (materials included). Class meetings: Saturday mornings - Oct. 7, 21 and 28 from 10 - 11:30PM

LEARNING TO WHEEL (Ages 16 and up) If you ever wanted to find out how much fun it is to throw vessels on a pottery wheel this is the class for you. The basics for throwing, trimming and glazing will be shown to beginners or those who need a refresher. \$ 270 (materials included). Class meetings: Sat. afternoons/evening* - Oct. 7, 2, Nov 4. from 2 - 4PM *3rd class (Oct. 28 from 5:30 - 7:30PM) will meet in the evening.


